1890	Dr. Yusef Bey Gabay (Miralay – Colonel) <i>"Ertuðrul Frigate Disaster" The Ertuðrul vessel which had left the Ottoman Empire in 1890 to convey a diplomatic message of Sultan Abdul Hamid II to Japanese Emperor Tenno Meiji, sank near Kushimoto due to loss of power after encountering a typhoon. It subsequently drifted into a reef, and the wooden ship exploded. A total of 597 sailors, including Admiral Osman Pasha, the commander of the ship died in the sea calamity. Only 68 members of the crew of the ship "Ertuðrul" were rescued. The sailors who lost their lives in the sea calamity, are commemorated in Turkey with a ceremony that is held every year.</i>	Killed during the Ertuðrul Disaster 1892
